Principal's Welcome Back

Welcome back everyone! We are so excited to see all of our kids and families on Thursday and look forward to an amazing year together learning, growing and having fun. Here are few reminders about our start up for you:

- * **Grades 1-6** start school **Tuesday, September 5**. This is a regular school day.
- * Kindergarten has a staggered entry on Tuesday September 5. Mrs. Lidgren has communicated this plan to our Kinder parents. If you have any questions, please feel free to call her at the school.
- Hours of Instruction: Our bell times are 8:41 am to 3:05 pm. Supervision begins at 8:30am. Students should not be dropped off or arrive before this time. Students are dismissed at 3:05 to board their buses, walk home or be picked up.

* Our Drop Off and Pick Up routine - Please keep your child in your car until supervision starts at 8:30 am. Once you see supervisors outside they can exit the vehicle and walk into the playground using the sidewalks.

At the end of the day, your child will meet you at your car at the front of the school. Please plan to arrive between 3:05 - 3:15pm. Arriving super early creates a long line out onto the highway. Parents/drivers simply stay in the car. This is a great opportunity for us to connect with you! Thank you for being kind and letting folks merge into the line and for being patient. It is a quick process once kids come out.

Bus students are supervised as they get on and off their buses.

- * Check in at Office: If you have to drop your child off late or pick them up early you will need to sign them in or out at the office. If your child forgets a back pack, lunch or anything else, please drop off those items to the office.
- * **Absent or Late:** If your child is going to be absent or late, please email your teacher or call our office to let us know. We call home if we haven't heard from you and your child is absent. If your child rides the bus, you must let their bus driver know of any absences or change of plans. They will share their cell with you.
- * Attendance Matters As we move back to our regular school routines, we want to remind you how important regular attendance is. To the side is a graphic that highlights the positives of consistent attendance and the impact it has on achievement. Your child's teacher is here to help if your child is struggling with attendance or is ill. We are a team when it comes to supporting your child's attendance. Please reach out to us if your need some support with your child's attendance and we will do the same!



National Day of Truth & Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day - Friday September 29

Orange Shirt Day is a legacy of the St. Joseph Mission Residential School Commemoration Event held in Williams Lake in the spring of 2013. It grew out of residential school survivor Phyllis Webstad's account of losing the shiny new orange shirt her granny gave her on her first day of school at the Mission, and it has become an opportunity to teach about the legacy of residential schools and anti-racism education in all Canadian schools. Orange Shirt Day is also an opportunity for First Nations, local governments, schools and community agencies to come together in the spirit of reconciliation and hope for generations of children to come because 'every child matters'. To add to the importance of reconciliation. September is now recognized as National Day of Truth and Reconciliation. As we learn together about this day, we invite all students to join our staff in wearing an orange shirt on September 29.

Contact Hours


